LAUREN REDHEAD (Organ)

Lauren's programme will celebrate the organ as an instrument of rich possibilities. She will present music which situates the organ as belonging to both the past and the present, performing some rarely-heard works by Benjamin Britten alongside two new works specially written for the occasion. The programme brings together themes of rich harmony and polyphony within music from the nineteenth, twentieth, and twenty first centuries.

Lauren Redhead is an organist and a composer from Manchester, who now lives in West Yorkshire. She has premiered works by, amongst others, Chris Newman, Nick Williams, Scott McLaughlin, Caroline Lucas and Adam Fergler.

Cyfansoddwyd chwechawd delynegol John Ireland ychydig cyn i gerddoriaeth Stravinsky, Ravel a Debussy gael dylanwad mawr arno. Ysbrydoliaeth tirlun gogoneddus lle cyn yn ardal Llanberis gyda'i olygfeydd syfrdanol o fynyddoedd Eryri ysgogodd Dafydd Bullock i gyfansoddi 'Fachwen'. Yna cawn ein tywys o ddrama mynyddoedd Cymreig i ddrama fawr cerddoriaeth Weber. Mae pumawd Weber yn dangos ei ddylanwadau o fyd opera drwy linellau alawon llawn mynegiant. Coronir y cwbl gyda phumawd Mozart ar gyfer 2 feiolin, 2 fiola a sielo sydd yn dangos ambell ennyd o Mozart ar ei orau.

John Ireland: Sextet (1898)

John Ireland's Sextet is both poetic and lyrical being music just predating the profound impact which the music of Stravinsky, Ravel and Debussy subsequently would have on him. 'Fachwen' by Dafydd Bullock draws its inspiration from the idyllic location near Llanberis with its stunning views of the Snowdonia mountain range. The performers then take us from the drama of Welsh mountains to the high drama of Weber's music. Weber's Quintet demonstrates its influences from the world of opera by virtue of the high degree of virtuosity and supremely expressive melodic lines. Mozart's Horn Quintet scored for 2 violins, 2 violas and cello has moments of Mozart at his best.

Yng nghyngerdd y semester hwn, bydd offerynwyr Baróc Cerddoriaeth Gynnar Bangor yn ymuno â Fantasticus. Ynghyd â'u cyngerdd eu hunain sydd i'w chynnal ar 16 Chwefror, bydd y perfformwyr penigamp hyn yn gweithio gyda'r myfyrwyr cerddoriaeth am sawl diwrnod, a hynny'n arwain at berfformiadau o concerti gan Handel (Concerto Grosso Op. 6 rhif 10), Telemann (Cyfres ar gyfer Viola da Gamba a Llinynnau), Vivaldi (Concerto Op. 3 rhif 11) ar gyfer dwy ffidil a llinynnau) a Corelli (Concerto Grosso Op. 6 rhif 4), ynghyd â gweithiau siambr o'r 17eg ganrif.

EARLY MUSIC BANGOR with FANTASTICUS

Chris Collins, Thomas Schmidt-Beste and Christian Leitmeir (directors)

The Baroque instrumentalists of Early Music Bangor are joined in this semester's concert by Fantasticus. Alongside their own concert on 16 February, these virtuoso performers will work with the student musicians for several days, culminating in the performances of concerti by Handel (Concerto Grosso Op. 6 no. 10), Telemann (Suite for Viola da Gamba and Strings), Vivaldi (Concerto Op. 3 no. 11 for two violins and strings) and Corelli (Concerto Grosso Op. 6 no. 4), alongside chamber works from the seventeenth century.

The Early music vocal ensemble, after several concerts focusing on French and Italian repertoire, will turn their attention on music from Southern Germany and Austria c. 1500; the centrepiece will be Ludwig Senfl's glorious six-voice *Ave Maria ... virgo serena*, complemented by other motets and songs by Senfl and by his teacher Heinrich Isaac.

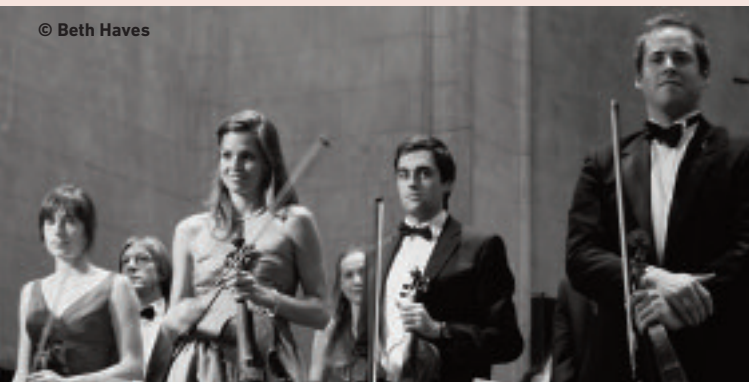

Mae Cerddorfa Symffoni'r Brifysgol yn archwilio nawsau a rhythmau Sbaen ac America Ladin gyda pherfformiadau o sgôr bale liwgar Manuel de Falla *El amor brujo* (dan arweiniad arbenigwr o fri rhyngwladol, Chris Collins) a Concerto cyffrous a phenigamp y cyfansoddwr Alberto Ginastera i Delyn. Yn ail hanner y gyngerdd, ceir gwrthgyferbyniad llwyr, sef un o symffoniau gwydachaf a mwyaf personol Schumann, a ysgrifennwyd ym 1841 fel anrheg ben blwydd i'w wraig Clara. Yn waith rhamantaidd gogoneddus, mae'r Bedwaredd Symffoni'n nodedig am y teimladau dwys a fynegir, a'i phedwar symudiad wedi'u huno gan un thema gyffredin.

The University Symphony Orchestra explores the moods and rhythms of Spain and Latin America with performances of Manuel de Falla's colourful ballet score *El amor brujo* (under internationally renowned Falla expert Chris Collins) and the Argentinian composer Alberto Ginastera's excitingly virtuosic Harp Concerto. The second half of the concert presents a complete contrast, with one of Schumann's finest and most personal symphonies, written in 1841 as a birthday gift for his wife Clara. A gloriously romantic work, the Fourth Symphony is remarkable for its intensity of feeling, its four conjoined movements unified by a single theme.

HUW WARREN & IAIN BALLAMY

Mae Iain Bellamy yn ymuno â phianydd jazz mwyaf adnabyddus Gogledd Cymru ar gyfer cyngerdd o gerddoriaeth yn seiliedig ar storiâu *Kiss Kiss* Roald Dahl.

A hwythau wedi'u disgrifio'n ddiweddar gan y Guardian fel "enduringly innovative", mae Warren a Bellamy ar flaen y gad ar sîn jazz y DU ers 20 mlynedd. Mae'r ddau wedi ennill gwobr Jazz y BBC am Arloesi, ac yn cyfansoddi a pherfformio gweithiau sy'n croesi'n rhwydd y ffiniau rhwng Jazz, Cerddoriaeth Werin a Cherddoriaeth Fyd-Eang. Gan gyfuno chwarae byrfyfyr penigamp â thelynegiaeth ddwys, mae cerddoriaeth gan gyfansoddwyr mor amrywiol â John Dowland, Hermeto Pascoal a Chopin wedi dylanwadu ar eu repertoire, sydd bob amser wedi'i seilio ar synnwyr digrifwch ysgafn. Yn ddiweddar, buont yn cyflwyno cyfres estynedig newydd o eiddo Huw Warren yn Kings Place, Llundain, ac maent hefyd yn rhan o driawd "Quercus" gyda'r gantores June Tabor.

HUW WARREN & IAIN BALLAMY

North Wales's best-known jazz pianist is joined by Iain Ballamy for a concert of music based on Roald Dahl's *Kiss Kiss* stories.

Recently described by the Guardian as "enduringly innovative" Warren and Ballamy have been at the cutting edge of the UK Jazz scene for the last 20 years. Both are winners of the BBC Jazz award for Innovation, and are composers and performers whose work easily crosses the divides between Jazz, Folk and World music. Combining virtuoso improvising with deep lyricism their repertoire is influenced by music as varied as John Dowland, Hermeto Pascoal and Chopin, and always underpinned by a gentle sense of humour. They recently presented a new extended suite of Huw Warren's at London's Kings Place and are also part of the trio "Quercus" with singer June Tabor.

In his Seventh Symphony Dvořák cast aside his usual sunny and cheerful personality to create a drama of dark-grained swarthy tragedy. Spontaneous, passionate and melodically inspired, Bruch's First Violin Concerto is one of the best known and loved of all concertos, described by Joachim as rich and enchanting. Both are heard next to the brooding romantic drama of Tchaikovsky's overture, *Hamlet*.
