Evolving programme :

- **Basic 'core workshops** : Lit. searching; Refworks; Systematic review etc...
- **In-depth workshops to fit with PhD milestones** : Effective researcher; Bangor Grad School; Making progress in year 2 ; Finish up and move on.
- **Specialist workshops** : Intro. to R; Statistical modelling in R; Programming in R; Advanced graphics in R; PRIMER; MATLAB; Nvivo etc...
- **Generic workshops** : time management; Welsh courses; etc.

PhD Training and Development :

- Booking system : feeds calendar ; helps with database
- Evaluation cycle each semester

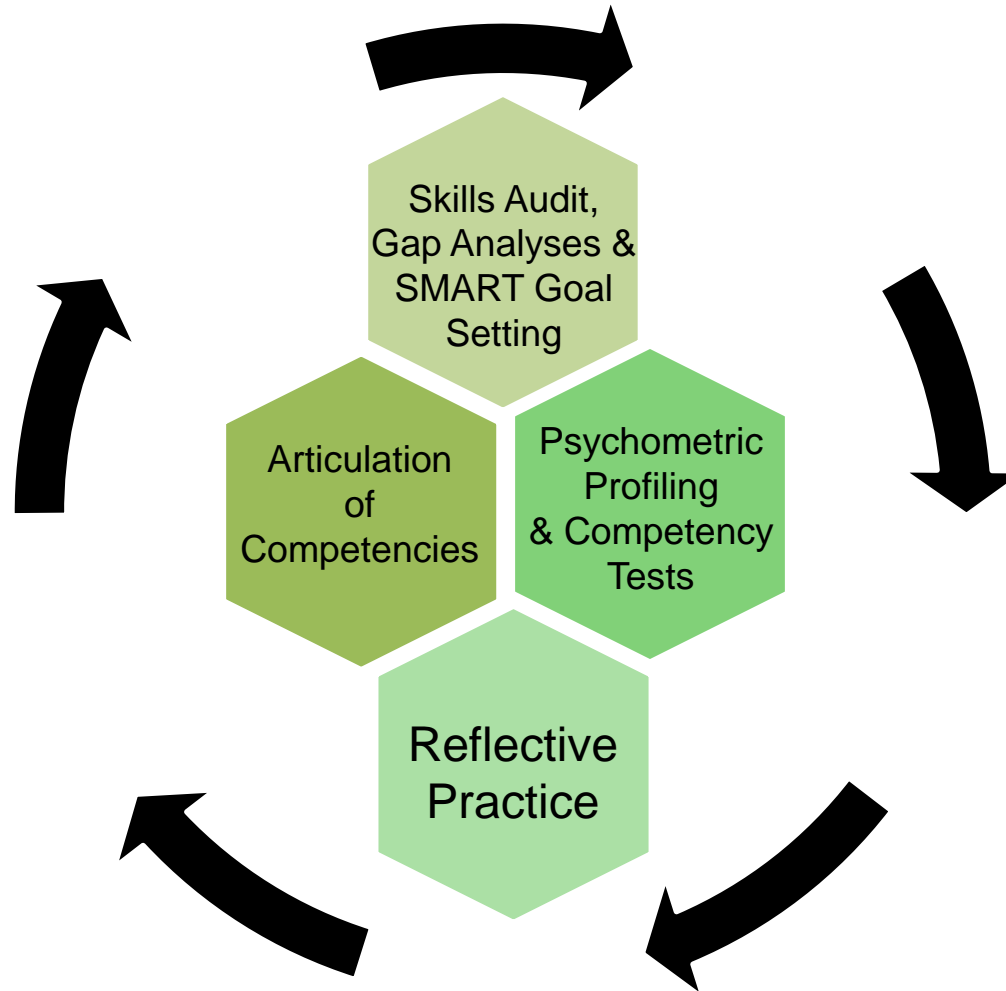
