SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WALES, BANGOR

1. *Delete* 'Prifysgol Cymru, Bangor' or 'University of Wales, Bangor' and *substitute* " Prifysgol Bangor' or 'Bangor University' in each appropriate place in Articles I, III, IV, V, V(A), VI, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, XIII, XIV, XV, XVI, XVII, XIX, XX, XXI.
2. In Article I ('The Corporation') *delete* the words "hereinafter and" and "the Statutes and" from line 4.
3. In Article II ('Membership'):
 - a. *delete* the text under heading "II Membership";
 - b. *insert* "Removed to Ordinances, 2007".
5. In Article V ('Powers') :
 - a. *insert* "of Bangor University or" before "the University of Wales" at both places it appears in paragraph (iii);
 - b. *insert* "Degrees" before "Diplomas" in paragraph (iv);
 - c. *delete* the words "in accordance with the procedures laid down by the University of Wales "in paragraph (x);

- d. *insert* the words "as prescribed by Ordinance" in paragraph (x), immediately before the first semi colon;
 - e. *delete* the words "and, in the case of Professors and Readers, the provision of the Statutes of the University of Wales" from paragraph (xi).
6. In Article XI ('The Court'):
- a. *delete* "Statutes" in line 5;
 - b. *insert* "Ordinances" at the end.
7. In Article XII ('The Council') *delete* "subject to the powers of the Senate as provided in this Our Supplemental Charter" in lines 3-4.
8. In Article XIII ('The Senate') *insert* "The Senate may exercise such other functions as may be conferred upon it by the Ordinances" at the end.
9. In Article XIX ('Standing Orders') *delete* the words "Court" and "Senate" in line 2.
10. *Insert* new Article XXV ('The Visitor') as follows:

" XXV. THE VISITOR

There shall be a Visitor of the University who shall be appointed by the Privy Council, on the nomination of the Council, from those who hold or who have held high judicial office."
