- Cynyddu'r defnydd o SALTO a drysau awtomatig i leihau'r pwyntiau cyffwrdd
- Newid y nifer uchaf o bobl a ganiateir mewn ystafelloedd sydd wedi eu hamserlennu/y gellir eu harchebu er mwyn cefnogi mesurau cadw pellter cymdeithasol
- Gosod marciau cadw pellter cymdeithasol yn yr ardaloedd hyn
- Cyflwyno model addysgu a dysgu cyfunol i leihau nifer y myfyrwyr sy'n symud o amgylch y campws ar unrhyw un adeg
- Sicrhau bod dau orchudd wyneb y gellir eu golchi ar gael am ddim i bob myfyriwr
- Sefydlu systemau talu digyswllt lle bo'n bosibl
- Gwella systemau awyru adeiladau lle bo'n ymarferol
- Trefnu cyfleusterau profi COVID-19 i fyfyrwyr ar y safle
- Datblygu'r ap presenoldeb Yma! i gefnogi profi, olrhain a diogelu

## Safe Campus

Most of our buildings are open, including libraries and the sports centre with some outlets also still open to buy food and drink.

We know things might look a little different, but all the measures which have been introduced are for your safety and that of our University community.

To make everybody on campus feel safe and welcome we have:

- Assessed all buildings and marked as Covid-secure to show they meet national public health guidance
- Displayed Covid related signs to guide and direct
- Increased hygiene and cleaning regimes
- Installed numerous hand sanitiser stations throughout all buildings
- Increased the use of SALTO and automatic doors to limit touch points
- To support social distancing, revised capacities in timetabled / bookable spaces
- Placed social distancing markers in these areas
- Introduced a blended teaching and learning model to reduce the number of students moving around the campus at any one-time
- Made available to students two free, washable face coverings
- Set up contactless payment systems where possible
- Where practicable enhanced building ventilation systems
- Arranged for on-site COVID-19 testing for students
- Developed the attendance Check-in App to support Test, Trace & Protect
