

EU, International and UK Nationals that have lived abroad

A DBS check for applicants with a record of overseas residence may not include information on convictions from outside the UK.

Should the applicant have periods of overseas residency, they will be asked to obtain certificates of good conduct from their home country (with a certified translation into English if necessary). The DBS can offer guidance on [criminal record checks in a variety of foreign countries](#).

Any applicant who has lived outside of the UK for 12 months or more within the last 10 years while aged 18 or over, will need to provide a police check from the country/countries previously resided in.

Successful applicants will be advised if this is required by the HR Department. Applicants must provide the original Police check / certificate of Good Conduct at this time along with relevant identification documentation, as advised.
