

**A focus group on EU infrastructure projects**  
**Where: The Management Centre, Bangor University**  
**When: Thursday, 20th October 6pm-9.30pm**

The purpose of these focus groups is to ascertain a better understanding of where small businesses have come into contact with EU funding or EU funded programmes, and what their views are on how effective these have been.

Based on the outcomes of these questions, we would like to find out what they would like to see prioritised from a future funding landscape, if the UK had more control over the budget.

**Participants:**

- Ideally participants, have had an experience of being involved in an EU funded scheme in some way.
- Again, in an ideal world we would have a wide range of experiences and an even mix of positive and negative views.
- If possible it would be good to have people who have had experience of EU funded business support schemes, EU funded access to finance schemes and people who may have benefitted directly from some of the EU money spent on infrastructure through ESIF.
