Efrydiaeth Ymchwil Ôl-radd blwyddyn o hyd gyda Choleg y Celfyddydau, Dyniaethau a Busnes (2022-23)

CAHB 1-year Postgraduate Research Studentship (2022-23)

Bangor University's College of Arts, Humanities and Business (CAHB) invites applications for a one-year studentship for MRes/PhD study commencing in Autumn 2022.

We are pleased to be able to offer **four studentships** as follows:

- **One award will be made to an interdisciplinary project** which brings together disciplines from within the College of Arts, Humanities and Business and either of the two other colleges in the University, namely: the College of Human Sciences or the College of Environmental Sciences and Engineering. The projects should speak to the University's research priorities. Applicants need to indicate secondary supervision in a school within the College of Human Sciences or the College of Environmental Sciences and Engineering as appropriate.
- **A further three awards will be made to projects within Academic Schools in the College of Arts Humanities and Business**, namely: the School of Arts, Cultures and Language; Bangor Business School; or the School of History, Law and Social Sciences. The successful projects should speak to the research priorities of the relevant School and College.

These awards are for Full-time study commencing September 2022 (for MRes) or October 2022 (for PhD). Interdisciplinary and Welsh medium projects are particularly welcome.

FUNDING AMOUNT

Candidates are invited to apply for funding for **EITHER** an MRes **OR** the first year only of a PhD. The funding offered will cover tuition fees and a maintenance stipend (£7,500 tuition fee waiver plus £7,500 stipend) for one year' full-time study for the academic year 2022-3 **only**.

Important: If applying for a PhD candidates must be aware that this studentship will be awarded for the first year of study only. They will be responsible for paying the tuition fees and living costs for the remainder of the course.

ELIGIBILITY

These awards are open to applications from:

1. Candidates with an excellent academic background in the relevant subject area;
2. **MRes** applicants should be in receipt of a 2:1 or 1st class honours; or those applying for the first year of funding for a **PhD** should possess an MA level qualification with merit or distinction;
3. These awards are open to both those who have existing applicants (who have already submitted an application to Bangor University for a full-time MRes or PhD with a September or October 2022 start date) and new applicants;
4. Home (UK) candidates only;
5. Those seeking full-time study commencing September/October 2022 only.

ASSESSMENT

The closing deadline for applications is 17:00 GMT on **24 August 2022**.

A final short-list of applicants will be put forward to a Panel, by which final decisions with regard to studentship awards will be made. In most cases successful applicants can expect to hear by **Monday 5 September**.

HOW TO APPLY

All candidates will need to make or have made an application through our online application system to study for an MRes OR PhD in **EITHER** The School of Arts, Cultures and Language **OR** Bangor Business School **OR** The School of History, Law and Social Sciences, commencing September 2022 (MRes) or October 2022 (PhD). *If you have already submitted an application for an MRes or PhD please see information for Existing Applicants below*

Guidance for New Applicants

A completed application form for admission to a research programme of study at Bangor University should be submitted to: <https://www.bangor.ac.uk/study/postgraduate-research/apply>

All applications should contain the following documents:

- 1. Covering letter:** The covering letter should set out your reasons and motivation for applying to study at Bangor University, your academic interests generally, and particularly those relating to your proposed research. The covering letter should be no more than one page.
- 2. Academic / Professional Qualifications:** Where appropriate, this should also include proof of English Language Competency (see institutional entry requirements).
- 3. References:** All applications require two academic references to be submitted in support. Candidates should approach referees themselves and include references with their application.
- 4. Curriculum Vitae:** This should be no longer than two pages.
- 5. Research Proposal:** The proposal should be up to a *maximum* of 1000 words.
- 6. A supporting statement** in which the application makes clear the ways in which the proposed project aligns with School, College or University research priorities (*max.* 500 words). Details of research priorities can be found by following the links below:
