


## COST OF LIVING



#### BANGOR STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMME

For individual students and students currently studying with a partner institution or at other approved universities. This programme is for Undergraduate and Masters' level students to study with us as nongraduating students for one semester or one year.

Study Abroad students can study courses/modules from across the University (excluding Nursing, Medical Sciences and Teacher training).

#### **Teaching Methods**

You will study alongside degree students and will be provided with the same teaching arrangements and support.

#### **Credits And Classes**

A full years study at Bangor is 120 Bangor credits/60 ECTS credits. Most modules are worth 10 or 20 Bangor credits/5 or 10 ECTS credits. A semesters study is 60 Bangor credits/30 ECTS credits.

Semester 1: September – January Semester 2: January – May

The main Academic assessment periods are in January and May. For students studying Semester 1 only, an early assessment is organised in December.

Credits will be transferred to your home University at the end of your study.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND FINANCE

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

You should be registered as a full-time degree student and have a good academic record at your home university.

English Language proficiency, an IELTS overall 6.0 with 5.5 in each component or equivalent is normally required (some courses may require a higher score).

APPLICANTS from USA, CANADA and AUSTRALIA may not need to provide additional evidence of English Language ability if they have been educated through the medium of English and/or are a passport holder for the country of their home University.
