Hardship Funds & Crisis Grant

Did you know that the university has a fund to help students who experience unexpected financial difficulties?

The **Hardship Fund** provides discretionary financial help to support students who face unexpected financial hardship or crisis during an academic year.

The Fund can provide emergency payments for unexpected crisis.

Who can apply?

The fund is available to registered Bangor University students - Undergraduate or Postgraduates whether you are from the UK, EU or an International student studying full or part-time courses

Crisis Grants

The Money Support Unit administer the Crisis Grant on behalf of the Students Union. The fund can provide small, short-term financial support to students struggling with financial hardship to ensure that students are able to purchase food whilst other longer-term financial solutions are being explored
