Terms of Reference:

1. To facilitate the implementation of the University's Sustainability Policies, Procedures and Action Plans and Environmental Management System.
2. Responsible for delivery of the Sustainability Strategy and reporting on its KPIs.
3. To receive appropriate sustainability and environmental Reports and Proposals.
4. Raise awareness of the Well-being of Future Generations Act (WFGA) framework for sustainability and how it applies to Bangor University.
5. To develop and manage the communication of sustainability issues to University staff and students and, where appropriate, the public.
6. To support Directors of Professional Services, Academic Leads, and strategy owners to prioritise and implement improvements across the University.
7. Collate information on current practices that address the Sustainable Development Goals. Apply the five ways of working to identify gaps, strengths, and weaknesses.
8. Where necessary create stakeholder groups/sub-groups.
9. Produce an Annual Sustainability Report.
10. Meetings will be held quarterly.
11. Report to the Estates and Digital Strategy Committee, which in turn will advise the Executive, Senate and Council, as appropriate.
12. Membership and Terms of Reference to be reviewed annually.
